 - c. In order to ensure a diverse repertoire for our Christmas concert and to avoid too many duplication of songs, we kindly request that you fill in the selected Christmas carol on a shared Google Drive spreadsheet. Click on the following link:

- d. Along with the video file, please include the lyrics and English translation (if applicable) of the Christmas carol you have performed on a word document.
- 2. Christmas Greetings: a short video clip in which member/members greet everyone a Merry Christmas in their native language.
 - a. Keep the duration of the video clip between 10-20 seconds.
 - b. It would be helpful to include subtitles or a brief translation in English.
- 3. Provide information so we can put on the video to introduce your group, for example, the country you represent, the name of the company or the name and title of an officer who performed.

- 4. Record all videos in a well-lit and clear audio environment, using high-quality video and audio equipment if possible. Save all videos in either MP4 (.mp4) or MOV (.mov) format.
- 5. Provide information of members who performed, for example, their names, titles and company.
- 6. Submission:

 - b. Select your fellowship folder, create a folder for your country, and upload all completed videos (Christmas carols and Christmas greeting), lyrics and translation, member information document on Google Drive.
 - c. Once you have uploaded your videos, please notify us at gbchristmascarol2023@gmail.com.
 - d. Please submit all videos and information by October 20th, 2023.
- 7. The final video complication will be uploaded to YouTube video for public viewing. Therefore, we kindly request that you obtain consent from all the members who participated in the video.

We are truly excited about these projects and the potential they hold to bring joy and inspiration to Girls' Brigade members worldwide. Your participation and contribution would be invaluable in making these visions a reality. If you have any questions or require further information, please do not hesitate to reach out to us.
